Vocational Nursing Applicants: You may take the A.D.C. if you cannot submit scores either from THEA (previously called the TASP) or Accuplacer, passing all sections, ACT with a score of at least 20 or SAT test with a score of at least 940. Remember if you have a college English and Math class with a 2.0 GPA, you may be exempt from taking any test.

Classes have tentatively been set to start January and May 2010.

If you are applying for January 2010 you must take the test no later than September 2009.

In order to take the **A.D.C. Exam** you must have your file complete. There is a \$15.00 testing fee that must be paid in advance to the Office of Admission. Your name must be on the list to test and you must bring a photo ID with you. The test will take about 2hrs and 45 minutes. You need to plan on being here about 3 ½ hours total.
