Teacher Education Admission Requirements

All application requirements must be complete and received in the Teacher Education Department before an applicant's file can be submitted to the Teacher Education Committee for approval.

The teacher education candidate must:

- Be a junior (60 semester hours accumulated) or have completed 60 hours at the end of the semester during which application is being made, or post graduate standing.
- Have an overall GPA of 2.75
- Have a GPA of 2.75 in each teaching field or area of specialization.
- Have a GPA of 3.0 in Education courses.
- Have a completed Application for Teacher Education, including an essay on philosophy of education and a FERPA statement, on file in the Teacher Education Office.
- Signed Texas Teacher's Code of Ethics
- Have a signed degree plan on file in the Teacher Education Office.
- Have appropriate Fitness to Teacher recommendations on file in the Teacher Education Office
- Pass the THEA with state passing scores of 220 in writing, 230 in reading, and 230 in math (no exemptions).
- Must take and complete IDST 2205, Critical Thinking, with a grade of C or better by the end of your junior year.
- Participate in an oral interview with the Director of Teacher Education to review the Teacher Education Program.
- Be approved as a Teacher Education Candidate by the Teacher Education Committee.
