Schreiner University is seeking dedicated, interested, and talented students to participate in the Symphony of the Hills, composed of Schreiner University students and instrumentalists from surrounding communities. The orchestra includes capable students who exhibit at least the following characteristics:

- willingness to participate fully in the orchestra program at Schreiner University, including participating in all rehearsals and scheduled performances;
- commitment to playing under the supervision and direction of the Director of the orchestra;
- willingness to abide by the judgment of the Director of the orchestra with regard to eligibility for continuing participation in the group; and
- evidence of success in instrumental performance, preferably with an organized orchestra, band or other ensemble.

To assist in recruiting qualified students for the Orchestra, some resources for participation grants have been set aside. Each of the grants awarded will be given for the academic year 2008-2009. Awarding of grants for continuing years will be contingent upon the evaluation, judgment, and discretion of the Orchestra Director. One-half of a student's total grant will be credited towards his or her Schreiner University account for the Fall semester and one-half for the Spring semester.

All applications received before April 30, 2008, will be considered. If resources remain available after May 1, applications will be considered on a first come, first served basis until available financial resources have been exhausted.
